It is hereby **ORDERED** as follows:

- 1. On November 13, 2019, Appellant GlidePath Marianas Operations Inc. ("GlidePath") filed a Notice of Appeal with the Office of Public Accountability ("OPA") following the denial of its agency level protest by procuring agency Guam Power Authority ("GPA"). That case is styled, *In the Appeal of GlidePath Marianas Operations Inc.*, OPA-PA-19-010.
- 2. On January 21, 2020, GlidePath filed a Notice of Appeal with the OPA following GPA's denial of its second agency level protest. That case is styled, *In the Appeal of GlidePath Marianas Operations Inc.*, OPA-PA-20-001.
- 3. Both Appeals before the OPA involve a protest of the Award in GPA-IFB-007-18, Renewable Energy Resources Phase III to Interested Party ENGIE Solar ("ENGIE"), and involve substantially the same questions of law and fact.
- 4. The Parties agree that the Public Auditor has the authority to consolidate appeals for purposes including efficiency and expediency in resolving appeals. 5 G.C.A. §5701; 2 G.A.R.

§§12101, 21108-12109.

- 5. The Parties have expressed no objection to these appeals being consolidated.
- 6. It is therefore **ORDERED** that OPA-PA-19-010 and OPA-PA-20-001 should be consolidated for all purposes including a single hearing on the merits of the protests.
