ORDER CONSOLIDATING APPEALS AND AMENDING SCHEDULING ORDER

The Public Auditor ORDERS:

- 1. The above-captioned appeals are CONSOLIDATED and the Scheduling Order issued on May 21, 2013 in OPA-PA-13-004 is amended as follows with the amended scheduling to apply to all parties in these now consolidated appeals.
- 2. The parties may file any additional motions by June 28, 2013.
- 3. Oppositions to the motions shall be filed by July 5, 2013.
- 4. Reply briefs shall be filed by July 12, 2013.
- 5. The Public Auditor will determine whether or not oral arguments will be scheduled on any motions filed or which may be filed.
- 6. With respect to K Cleaning Services' Motion to Strike, Appellee may file its opposition brief by June 26, 2013, and K Cleaning Services may file a reply brief by July 3, 2013.
- 7. The parties shall file their trial briefs, a statement of stipulated facts, witness lists, and exhibit lists by July 17, 2013.

- 8. The hearing on these consolidated appeals shall commence at 9:00 a.m., Wednesday, July 24, 2013, at the Public Auditor's hearing room, Room 907, DNA Building, Hagatna, Guam
- 9. It is further ordered that GIAA shall serve a copy of this Scheduling Order upon each other person or company who submitted a bid, including AMI, in order that any one of the other bidders may seek to participate in this appeal as an interested party; and
- 10. It is ordered that GIAA file with the Public Auditor a proof of service of the Scheduling Order that it served in accordance with the immediately preceding paragraph. The responsibility to serve a copy of the Scheduling Order on the other bidders is imposed upon GIAA because it is the entity that is most likely to have the correct names and addresses for such competing bidders.
- 11. All prior orders issued in each of these appeals shall remain in effect except as modified by this Order.
