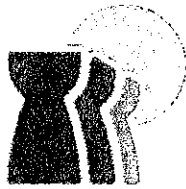

GSA's response to protest (Tab 3)

As we stated to the appellant on February 8, 2020, GSA reviewed the evaluation criteria based upon his protest letter of December 26, 2019, in which he inquired " ...whether GSA deems a "voucher type system" to be a part of the proposal and subsequent contract, what does the GSA deem a "voucher type system" to be?"

We stated that "in reviewing the law that establishes the criteria for the medical referral assistance program, a voucher system was a required item. See 5 GCA Chapter 1, Section 11.2(e)(1). As such inclusion of this system in the evaluation criteria was appropriate to ensure that it met the requirement of law. " The establishment of this system should not be difficult for a current contractor to capture the costs for running the program.
