15 COMES NOW, the Purchasing Agency Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority
16 (“GHURA”), through its attorney of record, Eliseo M. Florig, Jr, In-House Counsel, and the
17 Appellant Pacific Data Systems, Inc. (“PDS”), through its attorneys of record, Razzano, Walsh &
18 Torres, P.C., and hereby submits this Second Joint Settlement Status Report (“Second Status
19 Report”).

20 On May 29, 2026, GHURA and PDS filed an initial Joint Settlement Status Report with
21 the Office of Public Accountability (“OPA”) in the above-captioned matter. It was reported that
22 the parties were still in meaningful settlement negotiations and the parties had requested an
23 opportunity to continue negotiations, and to file a Second Status Report on July 6, 2026. However,
24 due to Guam experiencing Super Typhoon Bavi on this date and into yesterday, the parties now
25 file this Second Status Report.

26 The parties report today that they are still in settlement negotiations and would respectfully
27 request for more time to continue discussions leading to a possible settlement. Because of the
28

effects of Super Typhoon Bavi on GHURA properties throughout Guam, GHURA's executive management is indisposed at this time due to initial recovery efforts, and discussions of any settlement decisions may be challenging to be held at this time. As such, the parties further request that the Guam Public Auditor grant the parties the opportunity to file another joint status report on or before July 31, 2026.
