Pursuant to your decision on OPA 012-12, on Friday, October 5, 2012, I attempted to answer all of the protests filed in GSA bid number 064-11. Unfortunately, I discovered that I overlooked a protest filed by GTA on May 11, 2012. Prior to an appeal that was filed by GTA on October 8, 2012, (OPA-PA-12-016) I had made arrangements to start a review of the technical questions raised by the protest regarding bid form 11.

Since an appeal is filed on this matter and no response was provided, and that you had ordered a response to all protests within thirty (30) days in the previous appeal, I am requesting a ruling as to whether I can go ahead and response to this protest. Based upon my initial discussion with the technical advisor, I believe that it will take about two (2) weeks to formulate a response.

I am in receipt of your memorandum dated October 9, 2012, in which you informed the General Services Agency that Guam Teleguam, LLC (GTA) filed an appeal with your office, relative to the procurement solicitation (Invitation for Bid No. GSA-064-11). Pursuant to the rules, you are requesting a complete procurement record be provided by Tuesday, October 16, 2012

The Office of Public Accountability already has the complete procurement record of GSA-064-11, as PDS has previously filed an appeal (See case OPA-012-11). The complete record is over 1000 pages. We respectfully request that the OPA use the current procurement record without the need for the government to provide a duplicate record. You had authorize this also in OPA- PA -12-12.

For your information, there are still 4 or 5 protests that should they also appeal, there will no change to the procurement record that you already have. These protests have been submitted in the procurement record in OPA-012-11 and can be found on Tab 15, which is in book 6 and 7. If you require a complete record, even though it will be a duplication of what you have, you are looking at over 5,000 pages being given to you. We believe that in an effort to improve the efficiency and economic impact on the government of Guam GSA, we are requesting that you take judicial notice that the record has been submitted in OPA Case No. 012-11, and therefore meeting the record requirement of 2 GAR.

We hope that you will allow the use of the procurement record that you already have in the other case for this matter. For your information, we had already provided a complete record of the procurement record to GTA in OPA-012-11. Please inform us if this is acceptable or not.
