NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Pre-Hearing Conference and the Hearing re Appellant's Motion to Compel Entire Procurement Record in this matter shall be held before the Hearing Officer for Procurement Appeals at Suite 907, 9th Floor, DNA Building, 238 Archbishop Flores Street, Hagåtña , Guam, 96910 on Wednesday, August 10, 2011 at 3:00 p.m. For the benefit of the parties and their counsel, the Hearing Officer issues the following statement regarding the scheduled Pre-Hearing conference:

1. The Pre-Hearing Conference will focus on expediting the disposition of the appeal and may include:
 - a) Formulation and simplification of issues;
 - b) Possibility of obtaining admissions of fact and of documents that will avoid

1 unnecessary proof, stipulations regarding the authenticity of documents, and advance rulings
2 from the Hearing Officer on the admissibility of evidence;

3 c) The avoidance of unnecessary proof and of cumulative evidence;

4 d) The identification of witnesses and documents, the need and schedule for filing
5 and exchanging pretrial briefs;

6 e) The disposition of pending motions;

7 f) The need for adopting special procedures for managing potentially difficult or
8 protracted actions, complex issues, multiple parties, or unusual proof problems;

9 g) Establishing a reasonable limit on the time allowed for presenting evidence; and

10 h) Such other matters as may facilitate the just, speedy, and inexpensive disposition
11 of the action.

12 3. For the Appellant's July 29, 2011 Motion to Compel Entire Procurement Record, the

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
