OPPOSITION TO MOTION FOR 18 **EVIDENTIARY RULING** 19 Appellant. 20 21 22 23 COMES NOW, the GUAM POWER AUTHORITY, by and through its counsel of 24 25 record, D. GRAHAM BOTHA, ESQ., and hereby files its opposition to Appellant's motion for an 26 evidentiary ruling, authorizing request to admit to GPA, or an order to depose witness. 27 Morrico requests that the attached exhibits be used presumably for the purpose to establish 28 that Terex Utilities has terminated its distributorship with Mid Pac Far East. It also claims that the 29 termination is relevant to the issues on appeal. Exhibit B also indicates that if Mid Pac Far East 30 requests a quote from Terex for an installed product on a MPFE supplied chassis for Guam, Terex 31 will provide MPFE a quotation. 32 While the OPA may not be bound by the technical rules of evidence, there is nothing in the 33 rules that requires the OPA to accept anything offered by a party, without examining the relevance 34 of the documents, and determining whether the documents need to be offered in accordance with 35 the normal rules of evidence. The OPA has already given a scheduling order for the parties, which 36 requires the parties to provide pre-trial briefs establishing each party's position on different issues.

1	Morrico can state its issue with the documents in its pre-trial brief, and state its argument at that
2	time with regard to the letter and e-mail in Exhibit A and B in its motion. Morrico first argues that
3	the OPA should not be bound by the technical rules of evidence, and next argues that GPA should
4	respond according the Guam Rules of Evidence to a request for admissions, which is not contained
5	in the OPA hearing rules.
6	GPA requests that OPA deny the request submitted by appellant Morrico, and allow them
7	to state their position in their pre-trial brief.
