12 letters of the alphabet. The Purchasing Agency's Exhibits shall be
13 marked with corresponding and sequential capital letters of the
14 alphabet. The Parties may file stipulated joint witness, exhibit, and
15 issues lists, and admissions of fact in lieu of filing such documents
16 separately. The term "Exhibit List" as used in this paragraph refers
17 to exhibits that any party will present to a witness for testimonial
18 purposes during the hearing in this matter.
