CARS PLUS, LLC ("Cars Plus"), by and through Leevin T. Camacho, Esq., hereby enters its appearance as an Interested Party in the above-captioned case. Cars Plus is an Interested Party because (a) Cars Plus was the lowest bidder to IFB No.: GSA-097-13; and (b) Cars Plus successfully protested the award of GSA-097-13 on the grounds that, if Cars Plus was a non-responsive bidder, none of the bids submitted were responsive.

Cars Plus joins in the determination by the General Services Agency ("GSA") that the protest filed by Triple J is untimely. As Triple J concedes in its Notice of Appeal, it was aware of the cancelation of the award no later than August 8, 2013. The instant appeal is based on a protest that was made on September 10, 2013, thirty-four (34) days after Triple J admittedly knew about the cancellation. Furthermore, GSA had the authority to terminate the contract after

an award pursuant to 5 GCA § 5452. Finally, if this matter proceeds on the merits, it will be shown that Cars Plus was in fact the lowest responsive bidder.

Therefore, Cars Plus requests that its counsel be advised of any information that bears on the substance of the appeal, be served with all papers and pleadings filed hereafter in this matter, and be given notice of any and all proceedings or hearings.
