4 1. The Parties shall adhere to the following briefing schedule concerning the
5 Appellant's Motion to Strike the Appearance of SH Enterprises:

6 a. Oppositions. Any oppositions to the motion shall be filed and served on the
7 other parties no later than 5:00 p.m., on July 19, 2016.

8 b. Replies. Any replies to any oppositions shall be filed and served on the other
9 parties no later than 5:00 p.m. on July 26, 2016.

10 2. The Hearing Officer issues the following statement regarding the scheduled Pre-
11 Hearing conference. The Pre-Hearing Conference will focus on expediting the disposition of the
12 appeal and may include:

13 a) Formulation and simplification of issues;

14 b) Possibility of obtaining admissions of fact and of documents that will avoid
15 unnecessary proof, stipulations regarding the authenticity of documents, and advance rulings
16 from the Hearing Officer on the admissibility of evidence;

17 c) The avoidance of unnecessary proof and of cumulative evidence;

18 d) The identification of witnesses and documents, the need and schedule for filing
19 and exchanging pretrial briefs;

20 e) The disposition of pending motions;

21 f) The need for adopting special procedures for managing potentially difficult or
22 protracted actions, complex issues, multiple parties, or unusual proof problems;

23 g) Establishing a reasonable limit on the time allowed for presenting evidence; and

24 h) Such other matters as may facilitate the just, speedy, and inexpensive disposition
25 of the action.


