**DECLARATION OF VICTORIA  
G. BORJA**

I, **VICTORIA G. BORJA**, hereby declare and state as follows:

1. I am the Vice President and General Manager for L.P. Ganacias Enterprises, Inc., dba RadioCom ("RadioCom"), and have personal knowledge of and am competent to testify to the matters set forth herein.
2. RadioCom is a Guam corporation and is a vendor of an early warning system through Federal Signal Corporation ("Federal Signal").
3. RadioCom recently installed the Federal Signal early warning system on Rota.
4. In or about October of 2005, I met with Frank Blas, Jr., along with a representative of Federal Signal and advised that RadioCom had an early warning system which it had recently installed on Rota. Mr. Blas, Jr., stated that he was impressed with the system installed in Rota and also advised that a Request for Proposals would be issued for a Guam early warning system.


5. RadioCom is currently presenting the Navy with a proposal to install additional early warning sirens on the Navy base. The Navy is requesting sirens that are equal to or better than and compatible with their existing Whelen sirens.

6. The Federal Signal sirens are equal to or better than the Whelen sirens and are also compatible with those sirens.

7. During my discussions with the Navy I have been advised that the Navy will not operate its early warning system in conjunction with any system that the government of Guam might acquire.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of Guam, that the foregoing is true and correct.
