AGENCY STATEMENT

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GSWA denies the allegations in Morrico's appeal. The appeal should be dismissed. The Public Auditor lacks jurisdiction over disputes not "properly submitted" to her. 5 G.C.A.§ 5703; 2 G.A.R. § 12103. The appeal is not "properly submitted" to the OPA because both the underlying protest and appeal are untimely. See TRC Environment Corporation v. Office of the Public Auditor, Superior Court of Guam Case No. SP160-07, Decision and Order p.5, Nov. 24. 2008 (matters not submitted in strict compliance with 5 G.C.A. § 5425 are not "properly submitted" to the OPA). Even if the Public Auditor finds she has jurisdiction over the appeal, the matter must still be dismissed based on the Public Auditor's recusal or disqualification from 2 G.A.R. § 12601. A Motion to Dismiss has been filed concurrently hearing the matter. herewith. GSWA incorporates the Memorandum of Points and Authority in the Motion to Dismiss into this Agency Statement by reference.

CONCLUSION

The matter should be dismissed based on the Public Auditor's lack of jurisdiction or disqualification and recusal from hearing the appeal.
