12 such documents separately. The term "Exhibit List" as used in this
13 paragraph refers to exhibits that any party will present to a witness
14 for testimonial purposes during the hearing in this matter.

June 25, 2012 at 5:00 P.M.

12 The parties shall file and serve on the other parties, their Hearing
13 Briefs summarizing their arguments concerning contested issues
14 no later than this date and time.

14 **Hearing Date:**

July 2, 2012 at 10:00 A.M.

(Notice to issue no later than ten days prior – June 22, 2012)

15 The Hearing will proceed in the following order: (1) Opening
16 Statements of the Parties; (2) Appellant's Case in Chief; (3) The
17 Purchasing Agency's Case in Chief; (4) Closing Statements of the
18 Parties.

19 **Brief Re Remedies:**

July 6, 2012 at 5:00 P.M.

20 The Parties may, but are not required to, file and serve on the other
21 parties, additional briefs on the issue of Remedies no later than this
22 date and time.
