14 hearing. The Appellant's Exhibits shall be marked with  
15 corresponding and sequential numbers. The Purchasing Agency's  
16 Exhibits shall be marked with corresponding and sequential letters  
17 of the alphabet. The Parties may file stipulated joint witness,  
18 exhibit, and issues lists, and admissions of fact in lieu of filing  
19 such documents separately. The term "Exhibit List" as used in this  
20 paragraph refers to exhibits that any party will present to a witness  
21 for testimonial purposes during the hearing in this matter.

23 Statements of the Parties; (2) Appellant's Case in Chief; (3) The  
24 Purchasing Agency's Case in Chief; (4) Closing Statements of the  
25 Parties.
