

The mission of the Guam Commission for Educator Certification is to ensure that all certified Guam educators responsible for the education of our children are competent to perform their duties as teachers, school counselors, librarians, and school administrators.

GCEC is a separate entity governed by a seven (7) member Board of Commissioners. Over 3,000 educators and 5,000 certificates have been processed through GCEC. Some educators hold one or more certificates, while others have moved off-island keeping their certificate current.

- Hired a LTA staff member using ARP funds, to help with the office work load.
- Research procurement of needed equipment for save guard educator files, and website development with ARP funds. For safeguarding of educator files.
- Implementation of Identification Cards for employees.
- Provide online email of applications.
- Update of GCEC Social media presence.
- Provided online recordings of our regular GCEC meetings online as per OPA requirements.
- Jurisdictional Certification of Guam Community College
- Jurisdictional Certification of University of Guam
- We also streamlined our services through clarification of additional Standard Operating Procedures
- Attendance at Professional Practices Institute, NASDTEC
- FY2022 Budget Act appropriates funds for personnel only. Operational costs will need to be addressed using other revenue sources. ARP funds was helpful in addressing GCEC needs.

#### **Challenges**

- COVID-19 pandemic placed great restrictions on faceto-face service and operations.
- Budgetary restriction limits GCEC's ability to become fully staffed to fulfill all of the commission's mandates.


