AGENCY STATEMENT

GSWA denies the allegations in Morrico's appeal. The appeal should be dismissed. The Public Auditor lacks jurisdiction over disputes not "properly submitted" to her. 5 G.C.A.§ 5703; 2 G.A.R. § 12103. The appeal is not "properly submitted" to the OPA because both the underlying protest and appeal are untimely. See TRC Environment Corporation v. Office of the Public Auditor, Superior Court of Guam Case No. SP160-07, Decision and Order p.5, Nov. 24, 2008 (matters not submitted in strict compliance with 5 G.C.A. § 5425 are not "properly submitted" to the OPA). Even if the Public Auditor finds she has jurisdiction over the appeal, the matter must still be dismissed based on the Public Auditor's recusal or disqualification from 2 G.A.R. § 12601. Motions to Dismiss were filed in these appeals on hearing the matter. December 23, 2015 and January 19, 2016. GSWA incorporates the Memorandum of Points and Authorities of both prior Motions to Dismiss into this Agency Statement by reference.

Notwithstanding this submission, GSWA maintains that the Public Auditor lacks jurisdiction to review the matters as the challenged decisions were made under the authority of the Federal Receiver under the District Court of Guam in CIVIL CASE NO. 02-00022. Therefore, GSWA, under the management of the Federal Receiver, has proceeded with IFB-GSWA002-16.

CONCLUSION

The matter should be dismissed based on the Public Auditor's lack of jurisdiction or disqualification and recusal from hearing the appeal.
