**LIST OF ISSUES**

- Whether a bidder's voluntary withdrawal from an award of a contract constitutes a "termination" of the contract.

ORIGINAL

2. Whether award of the contract to SH Enterprises on November 30, 2019, violated the provisions of the Procurement Law [5 GCA § 5245(g)(2)] requiring that a protestant be given at least two (2) days notice (exclusive of territorial holidays) of an award absent a declaration of emergency by the Governor of Guam.

3. Whether GSA failed to properly respond to the issue raised in the protest concerning allegations that the bid of SH Enterprises failed to include information relative to its past performance of government contracts, specifically a list of past citations and a Certification Regarding Debarment.
