On June 16, 2022, the Office of the Governor of Guam moved to seal portions of the procurement record in Request for Proposals RFP-Office of the Governor of Guam-2022-001 that are required to be maintained as confidential pursuant to 2 GAR, Div. 4 § 3114(h)(1) and (i)(2), including the Register of Proposals, any and all Proposals submitted in response to

the RFP, and any and all discussions conducted with any Offerors after the date of proposal submission. The Office of the Attorney General provisionally submitted such existing documents separately under seal on the same date, June 16, 2022.

The basis for the motion is that these documents are required to remain confidential under Guam's Procurement Law in order to ensure the fair and equitable treatment of all proposals and Offerors; to foster effective broad-based competition; and to safeguard the integrity of the procurement process in accordance with 5 GCA § 5001. The request to seal is narrowly tailored to seal only that material for which good cause and legal basis to seal has been established.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the documents provisionally submitted under seal on June 16, 2022, are hereby ordered sealed; and future procurement record documents which are confidential pursuant to 2 GAR, Div. 4 § 3114(h)(1) and (i)(2), and Guam's Procurement Law shall also be sealed and submitted under seal in accordance with these provisions.
