

The First Performance Management Contract (PMC) Invitation for Bid (IFB). 17 1. On or about July 14 or 19, 2020, GPA issued Multi-Step Invitation for Bid No. 18 GPA-061-20 for Performance Management Contract for the Yigo Diesel 19 Generators (2020 IFB). 20 21 2. Section 3.1 of the 2020 IFB provided for the management of the Yigo Diesel 22 Generators, including providing and managing the staff needed to adequately 23 manage, operate and maintain the units. For staffing, this will include licensed, 24 certified and experienced technicians, service planners, service trackers, and 25 26

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- purchasing/procurement personnel, as well as five (5) GPA employees currently operating the units.
- 3. Section 3.7 of the 2020 IFB required that the contractor provide appropriate staffing levels of contractor employees to provide overall management, resident technical expertise for the operation and maintenance of the units, procurement & inventory control, engineering, and administrative support as necessary. The Technical Scoring will evaluate the contractor's proposed staffing level.
- 4. Section 3.8 of the 2020 IFB required the contractor to manage the GPA employees assigned to operate and maintain the Yigo Diesel Generators.
- 5. Section 3.9 of the 2020 IFB provided that the contractor has the responsibility to ensure adequate staffing.
- 6. Section 3.11 of the 2020 IFB provided that GPA may supply engineering and planning personnel services as required on a case-by-case basis.
- 7. On or about October 5, 2020, GPA sent Dooik a request for clarification on bidders' staffing of the diesel generators.
- 8. On or about October 6, 2020, Dooik submitted its response to the request for clarification.
- 9. On or about October 14, 2020, GPA sent Dooik a qualification notice to participate in Phase 2.
- 10. On or about November 19, 2020, GPA issued a Memorandum of Determination of Responsiveness to Bid and Recommendation of Award to award the contract to Dooik.

- 11. On or about December 2, 2020, Beatrice Limtiaco emailed Paz A. Tison and Jamie Pangelinan, notifying them of GM's decision to cancel the IFB due to changes in the specification requirements, specifically regarding overhaul of the units.
- 12. On or about December 3, 2020, GPA issued a memo canceling the 2020 IFB due to changes in the specification requirements.
- 13. On or about February 2, 2021, GPA issued the denial of procurement protest citing GPA's determination, upon further evaluation, that the specifications regarding overhaul of the diesel units were ambiguous and did not adequately advise bidders of exactly what GPA expected with the overhaul of the existing diesel units.

B. The Second PMC IFB.

- 14. On or about January 12 or 19, GPA issued Multi-Step Information for Bid No. GPA-023-23 for Performance Management Contract Yigo Diesel Generators.
 (NO WRITTEN JUSTIFICATION FOR USE OF MULTI-STEP IFB).
- 15. Section 3.1 of the 2023 IFB provides that the contractor will be responsible for the overall management of the Yigo Diesel Generators and did not include or mention the five (5) GPA employees as previously stated in the 2020 IFB.
- 16. Section 3.7 of the 2023 IFB provides that the contractor staffing should be composed of contractor management and possibly GPA Yigo Diesel Staff.

- 17. Section 3.8 of the 2023 IFB provides that GPA may assign GPA employees to operate and maintain the Yigo Diesel Generators and if GPA assigned employees, the contractor shall manage them.
- 18. Section 3.9 of the 2023 IFB provides that the contractor has the responsibility to ensure adequate staffing.
- 19. Section 3.10 of the 2023 IFB provides that GPA may supply plant operations personnel on a case-by-case basis.
- 20. Section 3.11 of the 2023 IFB provides that GPA may provide reasonable support from the Central Maintenance Section.
- 21. Section 3.12 of the 2023 IFB provides that GPA may supply engineering and planning personnel services as required on a case-by-case basis.
- 22. The Qualitative Proposal Scoring Information included the following Rating Guide:
 - 5 Excellent and plentiful relevant qualifications and project experience.
 Very highest client references.
 - 3 Average relevant qualifications and project experience. Average client references.
 - 1 Poor relevant qualifications and few relevant projects. Fair Client references.
 - 0 No substantial relevant experience.

- 23. According to the Qualitative Proposal Scoring Information, a bidder would need a minimum percent score of seventy-percent (70%) in order to be deemed acceptable.
- 24. There was no rating or percent score for "potentially acceptable" identified in either the Scoring Information or Second PMC IFB.
- 25.On or about March 3, 2023, GPA issued Amendment No. III responses to questions about the IFB, including Section 3.8 GPA Staffing, stating that bidders should assume that they will need to completely staff the plant, both in operations and maintenance and that no GPA staffing is available when establishing their bid prices and should GPA employees be assigned to the plant, GPA will ensure the appropriate individual have the experience and skills necessary.
- 26.On or about May 23, 2023, GPA notified Dooik that it had determined its non-technical bid to be unacceptable.
- 27.A review of the scoring sheets indicates that one of the evaluators left significant portions of Dooik's scoring worksheet blank.
- 28.On or about May 30, 2023, Dooik protested GPA's determination that its bid was not acceptable. Dooik pointed out that GPA had previously determined it to be an acceptable bidder in the First PMC IFB.
- 29.On or about September 6, 2023, GPA issued the denial of procurement protest, citing key differences between 2020 and 2023 project scope in that GPA would rely heavily on the contractor to perform almost all of the operational and

maintenance functions to run the plant and could not commit to supply personnel to assist with the plant maintenance. Dated this 4th day of December 2023. **CAMACHO & TAITANO LLP Attorneys for Appellant** SHANNON TAITANO
