



FINANCES

The Board's primary sources of revenue consist of fees collected from applications, registrations, and permit clearances. All revenue acquired by the Board is promptly remitted to the Treasurer of Guam, credited to the PEALS Board's fund account. In 2008, the Board initiated and has since maintained a Revolving Fund Account, in accordance with the authorization provided by Section 32109 (k) P.L. 30-55. This account functions as an escrow account, facilitating the direct deposit of garnished wages, permit fees, and vendor payments. This serves as a solution for instances when the requisition process through the Department of Administration extends beyond the permissible time frame.


